Project MentalHigh - Building mental health capacity at higher education institutes (HEIs) in Southeast Asia - is a 3-year project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union (Erasmus+ International Capacity Building Project 101082744) from May 2023 to April 2026. (Project Coordinator: HAW Hamburg, Prof. Dr. Gunter Groen)

The purpose of our MentalHigh project is to build capacity for mental health in (and through) HEIs in Vietnam and Cambodia with the long-term goal to transform the universities into health-promoting settings that enable students and all staff to thrive and succeed to their best potential.

The MentalHigh project applies a settings-based approach by addressing decision makers, academic staff, support services, and students through various interlocking mental health promotion and prevention interventions.



The main output of the Mental High project is a digital mental health platform, which provides students with easy access to mental health resources, ehealth, and a pathway to traditional on- and off-campus mental health support.




Kickoff meeting in Hanoi

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External Advisory Board and Student Board




